Post-Operative Wound Care Instructions

(For Circumcision and Minor Urologic Procedures)



Taking care of your wound after surgery is very important. Following the steps below helps you heal faster and avoid problems.

■ Wound Dressing Options

- Tissue Adhesive (Dermabond®): A medical glue called 2-octyl cyanoacrylate may be used instead of traditional gauze. It seals the wound without stitches and improves comfort and appearance.
- Wrap Dressings: Wrapping the penis gently with gauze may reduce bleeding more than ointment alone. Your doctor will let you know what type of dressing is used.

General Care Tips

- Keep the area clean and dry
- · Avoid baths, pools, and hot tubs for at least 1 week
- · You may shower after 24 hours, but gently pat the area dry
- Do not leave gauze on the wound for over 24 hours unless directed

□ Cleaning the Area (Starting Day 2)

- 1. Wash hands before touching the area
- 2. Rinse gently with warm water in the shower
- 3. Pat dry with a clean towel
- 4. Apply antibiotic ointment if directed
- 5. Use clean gauze or leave open to air, based on provider instructions

■ What's Normal After Surgery

- Mild swelling and redness
- A yellowish film (normal healing tissue)
- · Small amounts of blood or clear fluid

□ Pain and Comfort

- · Use pain medication as prescribed
- You may also take Tylenol or ibuprofen if your doctor approves
- Apply an ice pack over underwear (not directly on skin) for 15 minutes at a time to reduce swelling

■ Watch Out For:

- Fever over 100.4°F (38°C)
- Increasing redness, swelling, or pain after day 3
- Pus or bad-smelling drainage
- Bleeding that won't stop
- Trouble urinating

☐ Recovery Time

- Avoid physical activity, sex, or masturbation until your doctor says it's okay (usually 4–6 weeks)
- Children may return to school in 2–3 days if they feel okay
- Adults can return to work in 3–5 days, depending on the job
