Understanding Male Infertility



Infertility means not being able to get pregnant after 6 months to one year of trying without birth control. Male infertility plays a role in about 30–50% of cases and affects around 1 in 12 men.

☐ First Steps: How We Check Fertility

Your urologist will start with:

- A full health and family history
- A physical exam
- A semen analysis
- Hormone labs
- Scrotal ultrasound if indicated

□ What Causes Male Infertility?

Many things can affect male fertility:

- Problems with the testicles or sperm production
- Hormone imbalances
- Smoking, alcohol, or drug use
- · Being overweight
- Prior infections or injuries
- Exposure to chemicals, heat, or radiation
- Age and genetics

It's important to check both partners to find the cause.

□ Extra Tests (If Needed)

Sometimes more testing is needed, like:

- Sperm DNA testing
- · Genetic testing

□ Treatment Options

Many men can improve fertility with:

- Lifestyle changes (lose weight, quit smoking, eat better, improve sleep quality)
- Medications for hormones or sperm health
- Surgery to fix varicoceles or blockages

Good news: Many causes of male infertility can be treated, and natural pregnancy may be possible.

□ Emotional Impact

Trying to get pregnant can be stressful. It may also affect your relationship or sex life. Counselling and support groups can help. Don't go through it alone.

■ When to See a Specialist

You may need an andrologist (a male fertility expert) if:

- · You've had no success after treatment
- Your case is complex
- You're considering assisted reproduction (like IVF or ICSI)
